11/183	<p>Adjournment for Public Participation: 19.39 to 20.07</p> <p>Reports from:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Carlisle City Councillor J Collier: The issue at <u>Southfield</u> (unadopted Road) has been sorted out. Cllr Collier has talked to Phil Gray. Those caught <u>Fly Tipping</u> need to be prosecuted. A representative from the Council has been out and looked at the tipping with Cllr Pape. The PCSO is still interested in pursuing tipplers. There is a need to need to find out the legal standing about measures to prevent further occurrences. 2. Cumbria County Councillor T Allison: A letter has been sent re the <u>Fly Tipping</u> asking to clarify the Legal situation. The Clerk has a copy of this. <u>Two Castles</u> have been sent a letter asking for the strip of land adjacent to Burgh School to be covered with Tarmac or block paved. Matched Funding could be available for this. The <u>Flooding on the road to Moorhouse</u> is due to a gully that needs to be unblocked. <u>Shelter at Thurstonfield</u>: Kevin Crawley the Highways Engineer has been out to look at the proposed site near to the Phone box. Nearby House owners need to be advised of this if it goes ahead. <u>Grant for Play area</u> of £1500 will go ahead. 3. Other Committees and Councillors attending Meetings on behalf of the P.C Cllr Bradbury went to the celebration held to mark the completion of the Village Green project. An Our Green Space Project Booklet has been produced and an Education Pack for Schools. This is a general Education Pack that could be used with the field. Projects are going ahead identifying insects etc. Cllr Collier sent a Link for wild flower seeds to Sue Olsson. The Gully Clearance has gone ahead opposite Birch House. Drainage Facilities are to be sited at The Bushes beside the Children's Playground in Burgh. C C Councillor J Collier left at 20.09 in order to attend another Meeting.

11/185	Fly tipping notices : The Notices are assembled and just need to be sited. Cllr Roe thought that the Landowner should be consulted as to the exact location and will take a notice for him to see. Cllr Norman will pinpoint the Location for the Moorhouse Notice. The Clerk is to write a letter of Acceptance and Thanks to Mr Nichol for his kind offer of a Barrier/Gate.

The Parish Council agreed that this would be acceptable and Vice Chair suggested that similar Road Markings could be put at the West End of the Village. Cllr Roe proposed that this go forward to the Highways and Cllr Pape seconded it
11/187	Queens Jubilee: A full discussion about this to be postponed until the next Meeting. Councillor Roe proposed that Cllr Bradbury should represent the Parish Council in discussions and liaise with P Ditch. Cllr Pape agreed to lead this project liaising with interested parties in order to meet and consider how best to move forward.
11/188	Quaker Burial Ground – Proposals : A letter to be sent to the effect that any work on the Burial Ground should be arranged by the Economic Development Officer directly with the Quakers.
11/189	Ratification of decisions from Committees :Prevention of Fly Tipping, Playgrounds and Footpaths Playground Committee A decision has been made to accept the quote from Playforce and this will go ahead this week. The Playground will then be prepared ready for the equipment to be installed, David Holiday will store the equipment until this time. £900 has been allocated for remedial work as per the risk assessment. Further work to Trees in the Playground will be considered.
